Suncoast Trail Closure

Part of the Suncoast Trail in Pasco County, between State Road 52 and State Road 54 will be closed February 27 through March 9, 2018 for repairs and resurfacing.

The project is one of Pasco County Parks, Recreation and Natural Resources' scheduled maintenance plans to improve the Suncoast Multi-Use Trail. The trail will be resurfaced to repair any existing uneven areas and any deteriorating sides making the trailsafer for walkers and bikers to pass one another.

The closure will include all trail access south of State Road 52 and north of State Road 54 –including access points through Starkey Park and the Suncoast Lakes subdivision. Pasco County reminds everyone to stay off the trail during this construction work.

Hazard Mitigation Grants!

The Florida Division of Emergency Management (the Division) is pleased to announce the availability of Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funds as a result of the recent Presidential Disaster Declaration for Hurricane Irma (FEMA 4337-DR-FL).

HMGP funding is authorized by Section 404 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief Act. This funding helps communities implement measures to reduce or eliminate longterm risk to people and property from natural hazards and their effects. The Division encourages all potential applicants to submit applications for projects that address eligible mitigation activities. The amount of HMGP funding available to the state is based on the total federal disaster assistance for the Presidential Disaster Declaration.

Application Timeline:

Applications are currently being accepted. The application period will close August 6, 2018. Applications mailed to the Division must be postmarked on or before August 6, 2018. Hand-delivered applications must be stamped in at the Division no later than 5:00 p.m. EDT on August 6, 2018. The Division encourages potential applicants to submit complete applications before the close of the application period.

Possible SR-54 Underpass?

Pasco County's transportation board wants to find out if a big dig will work at the congested intersection of U.S. 41 and State Road 54.

County commissioners and elected officials from Pasco's cities, sitting as the Metropolitan Planning Organization, agreed last week to find out how much it could cost to build an underpass taking traffic beneath the existing highways.

The push for the cost study came as the organization was about to hear recommendations from its citizens task force, which spent two years improvements studvina potential to the intersection and the entire State Road 54/56 corridor. The group had winnowed 18 alternatives to four recommendations, including building elevated lanes above the intersection, at-grade improvements, and its top choice - a network of frontage roads known as a parallel-flow intersection. It did not study building new highway lanes below the intersection.

"I'm not saying it's the right option, but we need to look at every possibility," said Commissioner Mike Moore.

If an analysis determines the underpass is financially viable, then the MPO will send the proposal to the task force for additional vetting before it considers the group's final recommendations. The cost study is not expected to be completed until April.
