Openings on Pasco County TDC

Pasco County's Office of Tourism Development, Visit Pasco, is accepting applications from experienced Tourism professionals to fill three positions on the Tourist Development Council (TDC), which is responsible for providing oversight to the Tourism Office on tourism taxes expenditures – also known as the 'Bed Tax'. Applications are being accepted through January 19, 2018.

The TDC and the Pasco Board of County Commissioners (BCC) are looking for two owner/operators of tourist accommodations in Pasco and one applicant with an interest in tourist development. Applicants should understand the vital economic role tourism plays in Pasco County. Council members serve staggered, four-year terms. The TDC typically meets on a monthly basis.

Some of the responsibilities of TDC members include:

- Making recommendations to the BCC regarding the Event Marketing and Sport Event Sponsorship Program
- Overseeing department policies and procedures
- Providing funding allocation recommendations
- Serving as an advocate for tourism and destination development.

Pasco County Residents Dispose of 32 Tons of Hazardous Waste!

Pasco County Utilities staff collected 63,757 lbs. (32 tons) of hazardous materials during the annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection (HHW) event at the West Pasco Government Center on December 9, 2017, surpassing last year's total of 27 tons!

"This collection event is becoming more popular in Pasco," said Environmental/Hazardous Manager Charles Ryburn. "Every year, Pasco residents are removing more hazardous waste from our household garbage stream and preventing pollution in the process."

Pasco County staff helped unload 595 cars and trucks in 6 hours. The following is a list of hazardous waste collected and diverted from the solid waste stream:

- 25 propane tanks
- 220 gallons of used oil/antifreeze/gasoline
- 424 mercury-containing lamps
- 24,043 pounds of electronics recycling
- 21,900 pounds of latex paint
- 11,354 pounds of household chemicals
- 80 lead acid batteries
- 800 pounds of household batteries


